Bio, Requirements, and Criteria

Joyce M. Roland Jones was a very dedicated teacher who was very instrumental in the growth and development of many children over 43 years of teaching. She always said, "Education is the key to learning and becoming a success in life,"

She graduated from Booker T. Washington High School in Tulsa, Oklahoma in 1965 and 1969 from Langston University, with a Bachelor of Science Degree in Early Childhood Education from Wichita State University, in Wichita, Kansas.

In honor of her memory, her family has established this scholarship, through the Langston University National Alumni Association, for any student meeting the following criteria:

- Classified as a Sophomore attending Langston University (LU)
- Enrolled in Elementary Education program at LU
- Complete a 500-word essay on "How will I use my degree in Elementary Education to be a success in Life?"
- Maintained a minimum GPA of 2.5
- Complete the attached scholarship application
- An annual scholarship of \$500 (awarded \$250 per semester) and renewable for three (3) consecutive years if the recipient is a full-time student AND maintains a 2.5 grade point average.

I. Administration

- a. The Joyce M. Roland Jones Scholarship will be administered by the Langston University National Alumni Association Scholarship Committee.
- b. The Jones Family and the Scholarship Committee will have the power to review the scholarship guidelines and update them as necessary; reassuring that the update does not infringe on the wishes of the Jones Family and the Association's members.
- c. All children of an Alumnus, parents **MUST BE** members of the Association.

II. Application Process

- a. The application will be accepted until **August 31, 2017**.
- b. The Scholarship will be awarded annually.
- c. Applicants must be a sophomore enrolled at Langston University (Langston campus).
- d. Applicants must have 2.50 GPA.
- e. The application is available online.
- f. Please submit an application with all required documents to:

III. All Scholarship information

- a. Will be reviewed by a scholarship committee appointed by the LUNAA President. Selections are made based on a numeric evaluation system designed by the Scholarship Committee and the Jones Family.

IV. Distribution of Scholarships

- a. The five hundred (\$500) scholarships will be awarded \$250 per semester.
- b. Annual scholarship of \$500 (awarded \$250 per semester) and renewable for three (3) consecutive years if he/she recipient is a full-time student AND maintains a 2.5 grade point average.
- c. The **Honors Award Program** scheduled for **Saturday, October 21, 2017, at 7:00 p.m.**
- d. The scholarship can be applied toward tuition, registration fees, room and board, books, and other academic fees.
- e. The check will be made payable to Langston University.
- f. Names of successful applicants will be submitted to the LUNAA President and The Jones Family in **September**. The President will notify the students and work with the LUNAA Executive Director to have the funds transferred to the student's account. Each scholarships recipient will be notified in writing.
