Requirements and Criteria

The LUNAA Scholarship is made available to reinforce the importance of educating our LU students and to encourage them to make contributions in the areas of college education and life at and after Langston University. Scholarships are normally small amounts in terms of financial support, but they are significant because they recognize a source of history and accomplishments. Langston University has provided its students with the brightest opportunities and is now implementing ambitious strategies to take the University from excellence to greatness.

LUNAA is viewed as the premier support vehicle of the University and strongly believe that it should respond to efforts being made to support and maintain Historically Black Colleges and Universities throughout the nation.

I. Administration

- a. The Scholarship Committee will administer the LUNAA Scholarship.
- b. The Scholarship Committee will have the power to review scholarship guidelines and update them as necessary; reassuring that the update does not infringe on the wishes of the Association's members.
- c. All children of an Alumnus, parents **MUST BE** members of the Association.

II. Application Process

- a. The application will be accepted until **August 31, 2017**.
- b. The Scholarship will be awarded annually.
- c. Applicants must be a freshman, sophomore, junior or senior enrolled at Langston University (three campuses).
- d. A Langston University transcript must be submitted with the application. Freshman must provide a high school transcript.
- e. Applicants must be full-time college students with a minimum cumulative 2.50 GPA. Freshman must have a 2.5 GPA or better in high school.

III. All Scholarship information will be reviewed by a scholarship committee appointed by the LUNAA President. Selections are made based on a numeric evaluation system designed by the Committee.

IV. Distribution of Scholarships

- a. The one thousand (\$1,000) scholarships will be awarded (\$500 per semester).
- b. The Scholarship Committee will meet during the months of **August to September**.
- c. The scholarship will be awarded for one academic year; to one freshman, one sophomore, one junior and one senior.
- d. Recipients of the scholarships will be recognized at the LUNAA Honors Award Program.
- e. The Honors Award Program is scheduled for **Saturday, October 21, 2017 at 7:00 p.m.**
- f. The scholarship can be applied toward tuition, registration fee, room & board, books and other academic fees.
- g. The checks will be payable to Langston University.
- h. Names of successful applicants will be submitted to the LUNAA president in **September**. The president with the assistant of the LUNAA Executive Director will notify the recipients. The LUNAA Executive Director will assist the recipients with the transfer of funds to his/her LU account.
